## Get in "line" for Letters & Science Academic Advising

Text: L and S Advising to (805) 585-5821

You will receive a text asking you to choose:

- 1) General & Honors Advising
- 2) Pre-health Drop-in Advising
- 3) Pre-law Drop-in Advising

Text back the <u>number</u> to get in the line for the advising you need. For example, text back "1" for General Advising.

You will get text updates with your wait times. When you are at the front of the line, you have 5 minutes to get to the station ready for you in <u>1117 Cheadle Hall</u> for General/Honors Advising or in <u>2105 North Hall</u> for Pre-health/Pre-law Advising. If you can't make it on time, text back the letter "J" to go back to the front of the line.
