
Rural Medicine

Did you know?

- Of the more than 7,200 federally designated health professional shortage areas, 3 out of 5 are in rural regions
- While 20% of the U.S. population lives in rural communities, only 11% of physicians practice in such areas
- A recent study found that the rate of burnout is significantly lower among family practice physicians in rural settings than among urban practitioners
- To address the need for rural physicians, UC Davis School of Medicine and OHSU created a program called <u>COMPADRE</u>, a multifaceted program aimed at reducing health disparities
